



Focus Issue Application Submission Guidelines

Often times, delegates and committee members are drawn to SPAC hoping to find a state-wide forum for an issue of personal interest, and that's exactly what we're all about!

Focus issue idea submissions may come from any Junior League member in the State of Florida, and will be accepted through July 14, 2007, one week prior to our July 22nd Taskforce meeting. The deadline for materials submissions for the June Taskforce meeting is June 10th. You are encouraged to solicit ideas for focus issues from all members of your Junior League, and to introduce your issue to SPAC as soon as possible to get all SPAC participants familiar with your issue.

This year's focus issues will be selected by vote of SPAC Delegates from Florida Junior Leagues in good financial standing at our July Taskforce meeting in Orlando, FL, and approved by vote of the majority of member Junior Leagues' general memberships by the time of our Fall Conference. This schedule allows us the opportunity to further discuss our positions statements and to develop appropriate legislative strategies prior to the 2008 Legislative Session.

We currently have two focus issues that are likely to carry forward from last year:
